A Public Hearing will take place regarding an amendment to rezone lands along Main Road and Shoal Bay Roa d, Goulds, from the Rural Residential Infill (RRI) Zone to the Residential 1 (R1) Zone. This change reflects the recent upgrades to the sanitary sewage system serving Goulds, allowing more serviced development in areas tha t are already serviced with municipal water and sewage.

The proposed changes will generally follow property boundaries. In order to do this, the amendment will also in clude rezoning slivers of land at the edge of properties to better align with property boundaries. This will includ e rezoning small areas from:

- the Rural (RUR) Zone to R1;
- the Rural Residential (RR) Zone to R1;
- the RRI Zone to RUR Zone; and
- the RR1 Zone to RR Zone.

The St. John's Municipal Council adopted St. John's Municipal Plan Amendment Number 15, 2025, and St. John's Development Regulations Amendment Number 44, 2025, on April 9, 2025, and hereby gives notice of its intent to seek registration of the amendments from the Minister of Municipal and Provincial Affairs, in ac cordance with the Urban and Rural Planning Act.

The effect of the Municipal Plan amendment would be to re-designate land along Main Road and Shoal Bay Ro ad from the Urban Expansion District and the Rural District to the Residential District.

The effect of the **Development Regulations** amendment would be to rezone land along Main Road and Shoal Bay Road from the Rural (RUR) Zone, Rural Residential (RR) Zone and Rural Residential Infill (RRI) Zone to the Residential 1 (R1) Zone, as well as from the Rural Residential Infill (RRI) Zone to the Rural (RUR) Zone a nd Rural Residential (RR) Zone.

"In fall 2024, we heard from community members during the first round of engagement," said Counci llor Maggie Burton, lead for Planning. "We've listened to what matters most in each neighbourhood, and now we're checking back in to ensure the draft recommendations reflect those priorities."

The neighbourhood plans will translate the vision and high-level policies from the Envision St. John' s Municipal Plan to local policies and improvements for each neighbourhood. Initial recommendatio ns address the following key areas:

- Mix of land uses
- Height and density of development
- Transportation
- Open spaces
- Protection of natural and cultural heritage features

This engagement opportunity is open to all residents and businesses, with a particular focus on tho se living and working in the University Area and Cowan Heights. The project team will also connect with local community groups, institutions, and key interested parties. A variety of tools are available to support engagement, including:
